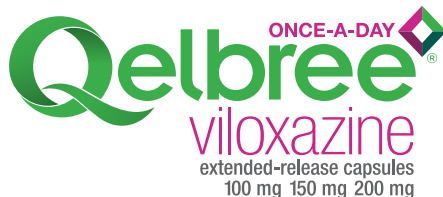

INDICATION

Qelbree is a prescription medicine used to treat ADHD in adults and children 6 years and older.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Qelbree is convenient:



- **Qelbree** is a once-a-day treatment that offers full-day medication coverage



- **Qelbree** can be prescribed by your healthcare provider via telehealth; there is no need for a new prescription each month to refill your medication

Qelbree may offer you consistency:



- **Qelbree** is taken once a day, any time of day (either AM or PM)
- **Qelbree** is with you throughout your day

- There is no evidence of abuse

Qelbree may cause manic episodes in patients with bipolar disorder. Tell your doctor if you or your child show any signs of mania.

Do not drive or operate heavy machinery until you know how Qelbree will affect you or your child. Qelbree may cause you or your child to feel sleepy or tired.

The most common side effects of Qelbree in patients 6 to 17 years are sleepiness, not feeling hungry, feeling tired, nausea, vomiting, trouble sleeping, and irritability, and in adults, insomnia, headache, sleepiness, tiredness, nausea, decreased appetite, dry mouth, and constipation. These are not all the possible side effects of Qelbree.

What is known about how Qelbree works?



The way **Qelbree** works is unclear but is thought to involve its ability to increase the amount of the chemical messenger called norepinephrine in the brain.

What is known about how Qelbree interacts with the body?



The **Qelbree** full Prescribing Information was revised to include more information about how **Qelbree** interacts with the body.



Qelbree is known to interact with the chemical messengers serotonin (5-HT_{2c}) and norepinephrine.



Qelbree is the only ADHD treatment shown to interact with the serotonin (5-HT_{2c}) chemical messenger.

Science can be complex—so be sure to talk to your healthcare provider if you need help understanding any of this information.

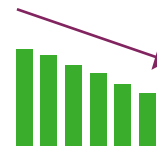

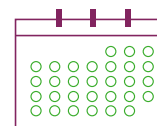

Qelbree is proven to work in medical studies of patients 6 years and older, conducted over 6 to 8 weeks—showing significant reduction in ADHD symptom scores in 4 medical studies of more than 1400 people.



In the 6-week adult clinical trial, treatment with **Qelbree** **resulted in a 41% decrease in symptoms** from the start of the study, versus treatment with placebo, which resulted in a decrease of 32%.



Qelbree reduced ADHD symptom scores as early as week 2 for some adults.

Qelbree has been proven safe* in a medical study of adults, with manageable side effects when taken as directed:

*Important: Monitor for mood or behavior changes. Your healthcare provider should also monitor for changes in blood pressure and heart rate.



- 9% of participants taking Qelbree discontinued the medical study due to side effects vs 5% taking inactive treatment (placebo)



- Qelbree is unlikely to have negative interactions with stimulants like methylphenidate or amphetamine



- Qelbree has been studied in breastfeeding women; talk to your doctor to learn more and see if Qelbree might be right for you and your ADHD treatment journey



- Qelbree is a nonstimulant, which means it is not a controlled medication:
 - There is no evidence of abuse



Reaching your best daily dose of Qelbree may be a transition.

Stick with treatment and work closely with your healthcare provider to adjust your daily dose of Qelbree if you are experiencing symptoms or side effects.

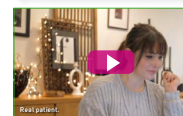

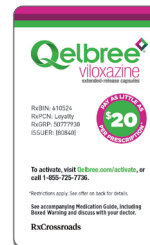
